

Socio-economic Status


- High school graduation: 68%

 - Households with kids: 29.1% (US 22.4%)





Causes of Death & Premature Death, 2011




Motor Vehicle Occupant and Opioid Overdose Deaths


- ≥1 day of poor mental health past 30 day

- Maternal depression: 19%








Incidence of pertussis, Oregon 1988-2012






Chlamydia incidence








Early Syphilis Infection


- >50% of the MSM cases 2006-2012 were HIV+.
- Cases meet sex partners in public sex environments: bath houses, clubs, book stores, on-line.




Cancer cases and deaths Oregon women, 2010




Cancer cases and deaths Oregon men, 2010



Obesity in Oregon Adults and 8th Graders








Oregon Diabetes Prevalence

New BRFSS weighting method began in 2010.






Behaviors that Kill Oregonians






Cigarette Smoking Prevalence by Year, Oregon 1996 - 2011





Percentage of Adults who Smoke by Age, Oregon 2011













Oregon Adults Meeting CDC Physical Activity Guidelines, 2009



Oregon Teens Exercising ≥60 min/ day, ≥5 days per week, 2011












Mortality by Race/ Ethnicity








Teen Pregnancy Rates by Race/ ethnicity, 2010




Smoking by SES, Oregon





Chronic Conditions by SES




Moving Forward
