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## **Defining Transgender**

- This is an umbrella term
- The transgender population is growing;
- o Current estimates show one million transgender adults in the United
- The transgender population has remained underserved and understudied

# What do we know about the adult transgender population in the United States?

## **Public Heath Issue: Background**

- Transgender population at a higher risk of multiple negative health outcomes when compared to the cisgender population:
  - o Gender-Based Victimization
  - Specific Health Outcomes
- o In addition to disparate health outcomes, the transgender population lacks access to health services
- Existing reviews of health services research on the transgender population are limited

## Objective

The purpose of this project was to

- identify gaps in existing knowledge
- provide recommendations for future health services research

#### By

- Quantifying existing literature
- Identifying themes

This review is unique and necessary with a focus on the broader content area of health services research as well as a narrow focus exclusively on the transgender population.

## Methods

#### o Data Collection

- PubMed, Sociological Abstracts, and PsycInfo
- Published 2008-2018
- Available in English
- Using data from the United States
- Focused only on transgender adults

#### Flow diagram of the literature search strategy


N = 39

o Data Analysis Combined search results N = 56,485 • Chronology Items removed due to filters • Data N = 56,074 Combined search results with filters Theoretical Frameworks N=411 • Themes Duplicates removed N = 33 Title/abstract screened N = 378 Excluded based on title/abstract N = 325 Full text items N = 53 Excluded based on full text N = 14 Final article selection




